7 (3) Only one raffle may be conducted under each special8 permit.

9 The total cash value of all prizes shall be no more (4) 10 than \$25,000 for each raffle. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act an organization may exceed the \$25,000 11 12 prize limit if the item being raffled off is a house which 13 will be used as a residential dwelling. The department shall issue a special waiver to any eligible organization which 14 15 plans to exceed the \$25,000 limit in order to raffle off a 16 house. * * * 17 18 Section 2. The Department of Revenue shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to administer and enforce this 19
