Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, " authorizing school districts of the first class to impose dress codes and require students to 7 wear standard dress or uniforms. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: Section 1317.3. Uniforms. -- School officials in school 13 14 districts of the first class ANY SCHOOL ENTITY may impose 15 limitations on dress and may require pupils to wear standard 16 dress or uniforms.
