## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for a limit on operating budget increases.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 13 of Article VIII be amended to read:
9	§ 13. Appropriations.
10	(a) Operating budget appropriations made by the General
11	Assembly shall not exceed the actual and estimated revenues and
12	surplus available in the same fiscal year.
13	(b) The General Assembly shall adopt a capital budget for
14	the ensuing fiscal year.
15	(c) (1) Any increase in an operating budget from that
16	budget of the immediately prior fiscal year shall not exceed the
17	average percentage increase in the personal income of the

residents of this Commonwealth for the prior fiscal year, as
 calculated by the Department of Revenue and certified by the
 Auditor General.

## 4 (2) An increase in the operating budget over the limit 5 prescribed in clause (1) may occur only by a vote of two-thirds 6 of all the members elected to each House.

7 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 8 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 9 10 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 11 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 12 13 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 14 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

15 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 16 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 18 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 19 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 20 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 21 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 22 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 23 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 24 25 primary, general or municipal election occurring at least three 26 months after the proposed constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly which meets the requirements of and is in 27 28 conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of 29 Pennsylvania.
