AN ACT

- 1 Providing a residency requirement for constables and deputy constables.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Residency.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- Constables and deputy constables for any
- 7 ward or municipality shall be duly registered electors of the
- 8 ward or municipality from which they have been elected or, in
- 9 the case of vacancy, for which they have been appointed. A
- 10 CANDIDATE FOR THE POSITION OF CONSTABLE OR DEPUTY CONSTABLE FOR
- 11 ANY WARD OR MUNICIPALITY SHALL BE A DULY REGISTERED ELECTOR OF
- 12 THE WARD OR MUNICIPALITY FOR WHICH THE CANDIDATE SEEKS TO BE
- 13 ELECTED OR APPOINTED. Constables and deputy constables shall
- 14 continue to be duly registered electors of such ward or
- 15 municipality during their term of service and shall reside

- 1 continuously in such ward or municipality during their term of
- 2 office.
- 3 (b) Application.--This section shall apply to all constables
- 4 and deputy constables one year after the effective date of this
- 5 act. No person or deputy constable shall be eligible for
- 6 election or appointment as a constable or deputy constable on or
- 7 after the effective date of this act unless such person is in
- 8 compliance with subsection (a).
- 9 Section 2. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect immediately.
