## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, authorizing certain charitable organizations to
- 3 solicit funds on highways.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3545 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3545. Pedestrians soliciting rides or business.
- 9 No person shall:
- 10 (1) Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting a
- 11 ride.
- 12 (2) Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting
- 13 employment, business or contributions from the occupant of
- any vehicle. This provision does not apply to a charitable
- organization registered under the act of December 19, 1990
- 16 (P.L.1200, No.202), known as the Solicitation of Funds for
- 17 Charitable Purposes Act, which has the approval of the

- 1 political subdivision in which the solicitation takes place.
- 2 (3) Stand on or in proximity to a highway for the
- 3 purpose of soliciting the watching or guarding of any vehicle
- 4 while parked or about to be parked on a street or highway.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
