AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 10, 1981 (P.L.214, No.67), entitled "An 2 act relating to the lawful conduct of bingo, prescribing 3 penalties and making a repeal, "further providing for prize limits. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 5(c)(3) and (d)(6) of the act of July 10, 7 1981 (P.L.214, No.67), known as the Bingo Law, amended December 15, 1982 (P.L.1299, No.293), are amended to read: 10 Section 5. Rules for licensing and operation. 11 12 (c) Operation. -- Each licensed association shall comply with the following restrictions and rules governing the operation of 13 14 bingo:
- 16 (3) Prizes awarded shall not exceed a value of \$250 for 17 any one game of bingo, except for jackpot games which shall

- 1 not exceed a value of \$2,000 for one such game. In addition,
- 2 no more than [\$4,000] \$8,000 in prizes shall be awarded in
- 3 any calendar day <u>and not more than \$16,000 in prizes shall be</u>
- 4 <u>awarded in any single week</u>.

- 6 (d) Application for license. -- Each association shall apply
- 7 to the licensing authority for a license on a form to be
- 8 prescribed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. Said form shall
- 9 contain an affidavit to be affirmed by the executive officer or

- 12 (6) The association in any calendar day will not award a
- 13 total of more than [\$4,000] <u>\$8,000</u> in prizes.
