## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," providing for payments on account of
- 6 pupils enrolled in special education programs.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2509.5 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 11 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 2509.5. Special Education Payments to School
- 13 Districts.--\* \* \*
- (p) For the school year 1998-1999, and each school year
- 15 thereafter, no school district shall receive less payment under
- 16 this section than it received in the prior school year. School

- districts that received revenue from any State source on account 1
- 2 <u>of special education in the school year two years prior which</u>
- 3 were less than fifty percent (50%) of the actual special
- 4 <u>education expenditures of the district as reported in the Annual</u>
- 5 Financial Report (AFR) of the school district for the school
- year two years prior shall receive an additional payment equal 6
- to the difference between fifty percent (50%) of the district 7
- special education expenditures minus the district's special 8
- education revenue.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
