## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," establishing the Pennsylvania Review Board for Interscholastic Athletics in the Department of Education.
8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an
12	article to read:

14	PENNSYLVANIA REVIEW BOARD

16	Section 2601-I. DefinitionsWhen used in this article,
17	"advisory board" or "board" shall mean the Pennsylvania Review
18	Board for Interscholastic Athletics established in section 2602-
19	Ι.

1	Section 2602-I. Board EstablishedAn advisory board to
2	oversee any organization which administers or regulates
3	interscholastic athletics in Pennsylvania is hereby established
4	in the Department of Education. The board shall be known as the
5	Pennsylvania Review Board for Interscholastic Athletics.
6	Section 2603-I. PurposeThe purpose of the board shall be
7	to review and oversee any actions taken by any organization
8	which administers or regulates interscholastic athletics in
9	<u>Pennsylvania and to ensure fair and equal treatment of schools</u>
10	and the students that participate in interscholastic sports
11	programs.
12	Section 2604-I. Membership(a) The advisory board shall
13	consist of eleven members.
14	(b) One member shall be the Secretary of Education. One
15	member shall be an appointee of the Secretary of Education,
16	known as the Education Advisor, who shall have served as one or
17	more of the following: principal, assistant principal,
18	superintendent, assistant superintendent, or athletic director,
19	of an accredited Pennsylvania school district.
20	(c) Five members shall be appointed by the Secretary of
21	Education to represent the regions which are consolidated
22	districts of the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic
23	Association (PIAA). Each region shall submit a list of nominees
24	to the Secretary of Education who shall appoint one member from
25	each list. The nominees from these regions shall be members of
26	one of the district committees within the region and shall be
27	selected by all of the district committees of that region. The
28	regions are as follows:
29	(1) Region One shall consist of District I and District XI.
30	(2) Region Two shall consist of District II and District IV.

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1	(3) Region Three shall consist of District III and District
2	<u>VI.</u>
3	(4) Region Four shall consist of District IX and District X.
4	(5) Region Five shall consist of District V, District VII
5	and District VIII.
6	(6) Philadelphia County shall remain as part of Region One
7	regardless of its district status.
8	(d) Four members of the board shall be members of the
9	General Assembly as follows: one senator, appointed by the
10	Majority Leader of the Senate; one senator, appointed by the
11	Minority Leader of the Senate; one representative, appointed by
12	the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one representative
13	appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
14	Representatives.
15	Section 2605-I. TermsThe term of the Education Advisor
16	shall be four years. The Education Advisor is eligible for
17	reappointment. The terms of the regional representatives shall
18	be four years. Appointments shall be made to fill the seat on
19	the advisory board from each region. Incumbent regional
20	representatives to the advisory board are eligible for
21	reappointment. The legislative members shall serve on the board
22	for the duration of the terms for which they were elected.
23	Section 2606-I. ChairpersonThe eleven members of the
24	advisory board shall elect a chairperson of the board every two
25	years in a secret ballot election. The election of the
26	chairperson shall be held after all seats on the advisory board
27	are filled and before the powers of the advisory board become
28	effective. The first chairperson shall be elected to serve until
29	the commencement of the next session of the General Assembly.
30	Thereafter, the chairperson shall serve for two years.
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1	Section 2607-I. PowersAll rules, guidelines and decisions
2	established by any organization which administers or regulates
3	interscholastic athletics in this Commonwealth shall be subject
4	to the approval of the advisory board by a majority vote. Any
5	ruling by the control board of any organization which
6	administers or regulates interscholastic athletics in this
7	Commonwealth on an appeal that is made from a district committee
8	may be appealed to the advisory board.
