AN ACT

1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for information  
3 relating to prospective child-care personnel.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6344(h) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 6344. Information relating to prospective child-care  
9 personnel.

11 (h) Fees.--

12 (1) The department may charge a fee not to exceed \$10 in  
13 order to conduct the certification as required in subsection  
14 (b)(2).

15 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) or 18 Pa.C.S. §

1     9121(b)(1), no individual who requests a report of criminal  
2     history record information or certification from the  
3     department as required in subsection (b)(2) shall be charged  
4     a fee if the request is made in order for the individual to  
5     make application to become a volunteer with an affiliate of  
6     Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of America.

8     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
