 repeals," providing for failure to pay medical education
 loans.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261),
- 10 known as the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act, is amended by
- 11 adding a section to read:
- 12 Section 15.1. Failure to pay educational loans.
- 13 (a) The board shall suspend the license of a physician found
- 14 to be in breach of a contractual obligation arising out of
- 15 receipt of Federal or State funding for medical education.
- 16 (b) Subsection (a) is subject to 2 Pa.C.S. Ch. 5 Subch. A
- 17 <u>(relating to practice and procedure of Commonwealth agencies)</u>
- 18 and Ch. 7 Subch. A (relating to judicial review of Commonwealth
- 19 agency action).
- 20 (c) The board shall immediately reinstate the license of a

- physician whose license is suspended under subsection (a) if any
- 2 <u>of the following apply:</u>
- (1) The physician is no longer in breach of the 3
- contractual obligation. 4
- 5 (2) The physician and the oblique have reached agreement
- 6 regarding the breach of the contractual obligation.
- 7 (3) The board is satisfied that the physician is making
- sufficient progress toward satisfying the contractual 8
- 9 obligation.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 10
