## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for penalties for 6 violation of compulsory attendance requirements. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1333(b) of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended by adding a clause to read: 12 Section 1333. Penalties for Violation of Compulsory Attendance Requirements. -- \* \* \* 13 14 (b) \* \* \*(4.1) In the event any child has twice been convicted of a 15 16 summary offense under clause (1), any subsequent offense under clause (1) shall be graded as a misdemeanor of the third degree. 17 The district justice shall refuse to accept for filing any 18
