## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, requiring reports of terroristic
- 3 threats in schools.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2706 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 2706. Terroristic threats.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (d) School terroristic threats.--The school superintendent
- 11 or chief administrator shall report terroristic threats of
- 12 violent acts occurring within school grounds to local law
- 13 enforcement officers.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
