8	§ 729. Trespassing on commission lands or waters.
9	(a) General ruleNo person shall, knowing that he is not
10	licensed or privileged to do so:
11	(1) enter or remain on any commission lands or waters;
12	(2) enter or remain on any commission lands or waters
13	when such lands or waters are posted in a manner prescribed
14	by law or reasonably likely to come to the person's attention
15	or are fenced or enclosed in a manner manifestly designed to
16	exclude trespassers or to confine fish or animals; or
17	(3) enter or remain on any commission lands or waters
18	<u>and defy an order not to enter or to leave that has been</u>

2	executive director, a waterways conservation officer, a
3	deputy waterways conservation officer or other authorized

5	(b) PenaltiesAny person who violates this section commits
б	an offense, which offense shall be graded as follows:

8	summary offense and is punishable by imprisonment for a term
9	<u>of not more than 90 days and a fine of not less than \$100 nor</u>
10	more than \$300.
11	(2) A violation of subsection (a)(2) constitutes a
12	misdemeanor of the third degree and is punishable by
13	imprisonment for a term of not more than one year and a fine
14	<u>of not less than \$250 nor more than \$2,500.</u>
15	(3) A violation of subsection (a)(3) constitutes a
16	misdemeanor of the second degree and is punishable by
17	imprisonment for a term of not more than two years and a fine
18	<u>of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000.</u>
