A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Department of Education to establish an "Adopt a Classroom Program."
- 3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives finds that business,
- 4 community groups, institutions of higher learning, labor
- 5 organizations, local residents, service organizations and social
- 6 clubs are endowed with knowledge, experience and financial
- 7 resources and have time available which could be shared with
- 8 this Commonwealth's public school students; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Greater community participation in education leads
- 10 to a sound learning environment and an active student body; and
- 11 WHEREAS, By working together, communities and the education
- 12 establishment can develop a strong working curriculum which
- 13 jointly meets students' needs and communities' ideals; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Collaboration between communities and the education
- 2 establishment will help to develop a skilled work force, ensure
- 3 a high rate of employment, create new jobs and foster new
- 4 business development; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The assistance to our public schools provided by
- 6 private nongovernmental entities may possibly reduce the burden
- 7 placed on this Commonwealth's taxpayers, who furnish the
- 8 wherewithal for our system of public schools; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 10 Department of Education to establish an "Adopt a Classroom
- 11 Program"; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the "Adopt a Classroom Program" serve to
- 13 encourage business, community groups, institutions of higher
- 14 learning, labor organizations, local residents, service
- 15 organizations and social clubs to share their vast resources
- 16 with the students of this Commonwealth's public schools by
- 17 adopting a classroom; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Department of Education formulate
- 19 guidelines for school districts to follow when locally
- 20 implementing and operating an "Adopt a Classroom Program"; and
- 21 be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the Department of Education publish and
- 23 distribute materials relative to the "Adopt a Classroom Program"
- 24 to school districts no later than July 1, 1999.
