## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating September 1998 as "City of Monessen Centennial  
2 Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is always pleased  
4 to recognize those municipalities which, through the observation  
5 of significant historic events, contribute to the continuity of  
6 Pennsylvania's great heritage; and

7 WHEREAS, The City of Monessen, Westmoreland County,  
8 Pennsylvania, celebrates the momentous occasion of its 100th  
9 anniversary during 1998; and

10 WHEREAS, Monessen is a community of approximately 9,500  
11 citizens situated along the Monongahela River about 28 miles  
12 south of Pittsburgh, and like other former steel mill towns, it  
13 is a melting pot of many nationalities; and

14 WHEREAS, Throughout its history, the City of Monessen has  
15 benefited from a succession of civic leaders whose guidance and

1 leadership have helped it to grow and flourish as well as  
2 citizens whose hard work and dedication have helped it to become  
3 a vital presence in this Commonwealth; and

4 WHEREAS, Today the City of Monessen looks forward to the  
5 future with the same hope that filled the hearts of its early  
6 settlers; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate  
8 September 1998 as "City of Monessen Centennial Month" in
