A RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming the week of September 13 through 19, 1998, as
2 "Rehabilitation Awareness Celebration Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The National Rehabilitation Awareness Foundation in
4 Scranton is leading the nation in observance of the "National
5 Rehabilitation Awareness Celebration"; and

6 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes and values
7 the educational, social and humanitarian contributions of people
8 with disabilities; and

9 WHEREAS, Individuals with disabilities have found hope,
10 spirit and dignity through the services of rehabilitation
11 medicine; and

12 WHEREAS, Rehabilitation services throughout our nation help
13 to restore individuals with disabilities to independent,
14 productive and fulfilling lives; and

15 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives proudly recognizes
16 Allied Services, founder of the National Rehabilitation
17 Awareness Foundation and the "National Rehabilitation Awareness

1 Celebration," for providing quality and progressive
2 rehabilitation facilities in northeastern Pennsylvania;
3 therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim
5 September 13 through 19, 1998, as "Rehabilitation Awareness
6 Celebration Week" in Pennsylvania and encourage all citizens to
7 renew their commitment to persons with disabilities and to the
8 efforts of rehabilitation medicine in improving the quality of
9 life for these persons.
