A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing October 12, 1998, as "Knights of Columbus Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Christopher Columbus told others about his dreams of
- 4 sailing a voyage in search of new lands; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Santa Maria, the Nina and the Pinta sailed from
- 6 Spain in search of a new world; and
- WHEREAS, On October 12, 1492, Christopher Columbus discovered
- 8 America; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1882 a group of Catholic men led by Father
- 10 Michael J. McGivney met at St. Mary's Church in New Haven,
- 11 Connecticut, and chose the name "Knights of Columbus" to honor
- 12 the Catholic discoverer of America; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Knights of Columbus is the largest fraternal
- 14 organization in the world, with nearly 2 million members
- 15 worldwide; and
- 16 WHEREAS, During the past 42 years, St. Joseph the Worker
- 17 Council No. 4215 in Levittown has been involved in many civic and

- 1 charitable works, including fundraising for Easter Seals,
- 2 distributing food baskets to deserving families and organizing
- 3 an annual senior citizen Thanksgiving dinner and St. Vincent's
- 4 Christmas party for children; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Knights of Columbus councils throughout this
- 6 Commonwealth contribute to community, church, council, family
- 7 and youth activities in keeping with the ideals of charity,
- 8 unity, fraternalism and patriotism; therefore be it

- 10 12, 1998, as "Knights of Columbus Day" in Pennsylvania; and be
