7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 8704. Plea bargaining prohibited for firearms offenses.
10	(a) General ruleIn the case of a firearms offense, a
11	court may not accept a plea of guilty to a lesser offense or a
12	plea of guilty to only one or some of multiple offenses charged
13	in return for a lighter sentence than the sentence to be imposed
14	for the more serious charge or charges.
15	(b) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
16	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
17	subsection:
18	<u>"Firearm." As defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to</u>

2	"Firearms offense."
3	(1) Any crime during the commission of which the
4	<u>defendant visibly possessed a firearm.</u>
5	(2) An offense under 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 Subch. A
6	(relating to Uniform Firearms Act).
7	Section 2. The addition of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8703 shall apply to
8	criminal proceedings commenced on or after the effective date of
9	this act.
10	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
