AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for schedule of convictions and points and for periods requiring lighted lamps.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $1535(a)$ of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended December 21, 1998 (P.L.809, No.151), is amended to read: § 1535. Schedule of convictions and points.
(a) General rule.--A point system for driver education and control is hereby established which is related to other provisions for use, suspension and revocation of the operating privilege as specified under this title. Every driver licensed in this Commonwealth who is convicted of any of the following offenses shall be assessed points as of the date of violation in accordance with the following schedule:

Violation of restriction on driver's license.

Violation concerning license.
Failure to obey policeman or authorized person.

Failure to stop for a flashing red light.

Failure to yield half of roadway to oncoming vehicle.

Section 2. Section $4302(a)$ of Title 75 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
§ 4302. Periods for requiring lighted lamps.
(a) General rule.--The operator of a vehicle upon a highway shall display the lighted head lamps and other lamps and illuminating devices required under this chapter for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles, at the following times:

(3) At any time when the vehicle's windshield wiper system is in operation except for temporary operation for cleaning purposes.
