AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for pedestrians soliciting
3 contributions.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3545 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3545. Pedestrians soliciting rides or business.

9 [No] (a) General rule.--Except as provided for in subsection
10 (b), no person shall:

11 (1) Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting a
12 ride.

13 (2) Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting
14 employment, business or contributions from the occupant of
15 any vehicle.

16 (3) Stand on or in proximity to a highway for the
17 purpose of soliciting the watching or guarding of any vehicle
18 while parked or about to be parked on a street or highway.

1 (b) Exception.--Nothing in this section shall prohibit a
2 person on a roadway from soliciting charitable contributions for
3 a volunteer organization.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
