AN ACT

- 1 Requiring rating of video games; conferring powers and duties on
- 2 the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency;
- 3 establishing the Video Game Rating Panel and the School
- 4 Violence Fund; prohibiting access by minors to video games
- 5 rated as obscene or excessively violent; imposing penalties;
- 6 and making an appropriation.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Short title.
- 10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Video Game
- 11 Rating Act.
- 12 Section 2. Definitions.
- 13 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 14 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 15 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 16 "Commission." The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and
- 17 Delinquency.
- 18 "Fund." The School Violence Fund established in section 5.
- 19 "Panel." The Video Game Rating Panel established in section

- 1 4.
- 2 "Rating team." The panel members who do the rating under
- 3 section 6.
- 4 "Unrated video game." A video game which does not have a
- 5 rating under section 6.
- 6 "Video game." An electronic game played by means of images
- 7 on a screen.
- 8 "Video game merchant." A person that engages in the business
- 9 of:
- 10 (1) selling video games;
- 11 (2) renting video games; or
- 12 (3) permitting the use of video games on the person's
- 13 premises.
- 14 Section 3. Commission.
- 15 The commission has the following powers and duties:
- 16 (1) Implement section 4(e).
- 17 (2) Administer the fund under section 5(e).
- 18 (3) Prosecute violations under section 7.
- 19 (4) Promulgate regulations to administer sections 4,
- 5(c)(1) and 6.
- 21 Section 4. Panel.
- 22 (a) Establishment.--The Video Game Rating Panel is
- 23 established within the commission. The panel shall consist of
- 24 100 individuals selected by the commission as representative of
- 25 the general citizenry of this Commonwealth in terms of age,
- 26 gender, race, religion, residence and occupation.
- 27 (b) Term.--
- 28 (1) A member of the panel shall serve a term of two
- years. A member may be removed by the commission for cause.
- 30 (2) No individual may be appointed as a member for a

- 1 second time.
- 2 (3) If a vacancy occurs on the panel, the replacement
- 3 shall serve the remainder of the term.
- 4 (c) Function. -- The panel has the power and duty to rate
- 5 video games in accordance with section 6.
- 6 (d) Compensation. -- Members of the panel shall serve without
- 7 compensation but shall be entitled to reasonable and necessary
- 8 expenses incurred in the discharge of their functions.
- 9 (e) Support.--The commission shall provide the panel with
- 10 staff, supplies, equipment and facilities.
- 11 Section 5. Fund.
- 12 (a) Establishment.--The School Violence Fund is established
- 13 as a separate fund in the State Treasury.
- 14 (b) Source.--The following are the sources of the fund:
- 15 (1) Appropriations.
- 16 (2) Fines under section 7(d).
- 17 (c) Purpose. -- The following are the purposes of the fund:
- 18 (1) To prevent and combat violence in public, private
- 19 and parochial schools.
- 20 (2) To administer this act.
- 21 (d) Continuing appropriation. -- The money in the fund is
- 22 continuously appropriated to the fund. This appropriation shall
- 23 not lapse at the end of any fiscal year.
- (e) Administration. -- The commission shall administer the
- 25 fund.
- 26 Section 6. Ratings.
- 27 (a) Options.--A video game submitted to the panel shall be
- 28 assigned to a rating team of three panel members for one of the
- 29 following ratings:
- 30 (1) Acceptable for general audience.

- 1 (2) Acceptable only for adult audience.
- 2 (b) Criteria. -- In order for a video game to be rated under
- 3 subsection (a)(2), the rating team must, applying Statewide
- 4 standards, determine that the video game meets one of the
- 5 following criteria:
- 6 (1) Contains material which:
- 7 (i) appeals to the prurient interest in sex;
- 8 (ii) depicts in a patently offensive way sexual
- 9 conduct described in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5903 (relating to
- obscene and other sexual materials and performances); and
- 11 (iii) lacks serious literary, artistic, political,
- 12 educational or scientific value.
- 13 (2) Contains material which:
- (i) depicts violence in a graphic manner; and
- 15 (ii) lacks serious literary, artistic, political,
- 16 educational or scientific value.
- 17 (c) Procedure.--
- 18 (1) A determination of the rating team under subsection
- 19 (a)(1) is final and not subject to appeal.
- 20 (2) A person aggrieved by a determination by the rating
- 21 team under subsection (a)(2) may appeal the determination to
- the commission. The appeal must be made in 30 days, or the
- 23 determination becomes final.
- 24 (3) Within 60 days of the filing of an appeal under
- paragraph (2), the commission shall, after notice and
- 26 hearing:
- 27 (i) affirm the determination; or
- 28 (ii) reverse the determination by ordering a
- determination under subsection (a)(1).
- 30 (4) Failure of the commission to act within the time

- 1 period specified in paragraph (3) shall be deemed reversal of
- 2 the determination.
- 3 (d) Administrative agency law.--A determination under
- 4 subsection (c)(3) is subject to 2 Pa.C.S. Ch. 5 Subch. A
- 5 (relating to practice and procedure of Commonwealth agencies)
- 6 and Ch. 7 Subch. A (relating to judicial review of Commonwealth
- 7 agency action).
- 8 Section 7. Prohibitions.
- 9 (a) Video game merchants.--A video game merchant may not do
- 10 any of the following:
- 11 (1) Display, sell, rent or permit the use of an unrated
- 12 video game.
- 13 (2) Knowingly sell or rent a video game rated under
- section 6(a)(2) to an individual under 18 years of age.
- 15 (3) Knowingly permit the use of a video game rated under
- section 6(a)(2) by an individual under 18 years of age.
- 17 (b) Other persons.--A person that is not a video game
- 18 merchant may not do any of the following:
- 19 (1) Sell or rent an unrated video game.
- 20 (2) Knowingly sell or rent a video game rated under
- section 6(a)(2) to an individual under 18 years of age.
- 22 (3) Knowingly give to an individual under 18 years of
- 23 age an unrated video game or a video game rated under section
- 6(a)(2). This paragraph does not apply to an individual who
- is the parent or legal guardian of the individual to whom the
- video game is given.
- 27 (c) Grading.--
- 28 (1) Except as set forth in paragraph (2), a person that
- violates subsection (a) or (b)(1) or (2) commits a
- 30 misdemeanor of the third degree.

- 1 (2) A person that, after being sentenced under paragraph
- 2 (1), violates subsection (a) or (b)(1) or (2) commits a
- 3 misdemeanor of the second degree.
- 4 (3) Except as set forth in paragraph (4), a person that
- 5 violates subsection (b)(3) commits a summary offense.
- 6 (4) A person that, after being sentenced under paragraph
- 7 (3), violates subsection (b)(3) commits a misdemeanor of the
- 8 third degree.
- 9 (d) Fines.--Fines imposed in criminal actions under this
- 10 section shall be deposited in the fund.
- 11 Section 8. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$3,000,000 is hereby appropriated to the
- 13 Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency for deposit
- 14 into the fund for the fiscal year July 1, 1999, to June 30,
- 15 2000, to carry out the provisions of this act. This
- 16 appropriation is subject to section 5(d).
- 17 Section 9. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect as follows:
- 19 (1) This section shall take effect immediately.
- 20 (2) Section 7 shall take effect on the effective date of
- 21 the initial regulations promulgated under section 3(4).
- 22 (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect in 60
- days.
