1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the removal of ice and snow from vehicles.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 3720. Removal of ice and snow.
9	(a) General ruleNo person shall operate any motor vehicle
10	without first removing all ice or snow. If a police officer
11	observes the release of ice or snow which was not removed prior
12	to operating the motor vehicle, the operator shall be issued a
13	citation.
14	(b) ExceptionThe provisions of this section shall not
15	apply to accumulations of ice and snow which occur while
16	operating the motor vehicle.
17	(c) PenaltyAny violation of this section is a summary
18	offense punishable by a fine of \$50.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
