A RESOLUTION

1 Declaring February 1999 as "American Heart Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Every 33 seconds someone in the United States dies
4 from cardiovascular disease; and

5 WHEREAS, Coronary heart disease is the leading cause of death
6 for Pennsylvanians; and

7 WHEREAS, Stroke is the number one debillatator and number
8 three killer in America; and

9 WHEREAS, The American Heart Association is the largest
10 voluntary nonprofit organization whose mission is to reduce
11 disability and death from cardiovascular disease and stroke; and

1 WHEREAS, The American Heart Association is instrumental in
2 educating the public and promoting cardiovascular disease
3 research and education; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare February
5 1999 as "American Heart Month" in Pennsylvania and encourage all
6 citizens of this Commonwealth to seek education in prevention,
7 risk factors and symptoms of cardiovascular disease and stroke.
