## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Department of Transportation to take the steps
- 2 necessary to have State Route 60 redesignated as Interstate
- 3 376.
- 4 WHEREAS, State Route 60 is a major transportation corridor
- 5 running through Allegheny, Beaver, Mercer and Lawrence Counties;
- 6 and
- WHEREAS, The State Route 60 corridor has the potential to be
- 8 a spur for significant economic development; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The State Route 60 corridor has the potential to
- 10 provide greater transportation capacity and efficiency for the
- 11 transportation needs of the region's citizens and businesses;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, The establishment of interstate highways throughout
- 14 the State and nation has led to significant economic development
- 15 opportunities; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The potential increase in economic development and
- 17 transportation efficiency could be enhanced by redesignating

- 1 this transportation corridor from Route 60 to Interstate 376,
- 2 thus continuing Interstate 376 through Allegheny, Beaver, Mercer
- 3 and Lawrence Counties; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 5 Department of Transportation to take the steps necessary to
- 6 redesignate State Route 60 as Interstate 376.
