AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to The Children's Institute, Pittsburgh
- 2 for treatment and rehabilitation of certain persons with
- 3 disabling diseases.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of \$870,000 is hereby appropriated to The
- 7 Children's Institute, Pittsburgh, for the fiscal year July 1,
- 8 2000, to June 30, 2001, for the treatment and rehabilitation of
- 9 children and young adults with disabling diseases. Payment of
- 10 this appropriation shall be made by the Secretary of Health in
- 11 equal quarterly payments.
- 12 Section 2. The Children's Institute shall provide full,
- 13 complete and accurate information as may be required by the
- 14 Department of Health or the chairman or the minority chairman of
- 15 the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or
- 16 the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 17 House of Representatives.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, or

1 immediately, whichever is later.
