AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, requiring certain essential emergency service
- 3 benefits relating to financial responsibility.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1711 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1711. Required benefits.
- 9 (a) Medical benefit. -- An insurer issuing or delivering
- 10 liability insurance policies covering any motor vehicle of the
- 11 type required to be registered under this title, except
- 12 recreational vehicles not intended for highway use, motorcycles,
- 13 motor-driven cycles or motorized pedalcycles or like type
- 14 vehicles, registered and operated in this Commonwealth, shall
- 15 include coverage providing a medical benefit in the amount of
- 16 \$5,000.
- 17 (a.1) Essential emergency service benefits.--An insurer
- 18 issuing or delivering liability insurance policies covering any

- 1 motor vehicle of the type required to be registered under this
- 2 <u>title</u>, except recreational vehicles not intended for highway
- 3 <u>use</u>, <u>motorcycles</u>, <u>motor-driven cycles or motorized pedalcycles</u>
- 4 or like type vehicles, registered and operated in this
- 5 <u>Commonwealth</u>, shall include coverage providing a benefit for
- 6 <u>essential services performed and costs incurred by emergency</u>
- 7 <u>service personnel in the removal of hazardous materials</u>, broken
- 8 glass and other vehicular debris from the scene of an accident.
- 9 (b) Minimum policy.--All insurers subject to this chapter
- 10 shall make available for purchase a motor vehicle insurance
- 11 policy which contains only the minimum requirements of financial
- 12 responsibility [and], medical benefits and essential emergency
- 13 <u>service benefits</u> as provided for in this chapter.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
