AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, permitting certain military personnel to hunt
- 3 without a license.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2706 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (e) Military personnel.--A resident of this Commonwealth on
- 11 full-time active duty in the military service of the United
- 12 States, assigned to a facility outside this Commonwealth and on
- 13 temporary leave in this Commonwealth may hunt, kill or trap game
- 14 birds, game animals and furbearers without a resident hunting or
- 15 furtaker license as required in this title. Every person who
- 16 uses this exemption shall have in his possession, while hunting

- 1 or taking game birds, game animals or furbearers, evidence of
- 2 <u>residency in this Commonwealth and a copy of the orders</u>
- 3 assigning such person to temporary leave. This subsection shall
- 4 <u>not be construed to permit any person to hunt for, kill or trap</u>
- 5 <u>any:</u>
- 6 (1) game bird, game animal or furbearer which requires a
- 7 <u>specific license; or</u>
- 8 (2) any game bird, game animal or furbearer at any time
- 9 <u>or in any manner or number other than as prescribed by</u>
- 10 <u>regulations of the commission.</u>
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
