18 Pa.C.S. § 5121 (relating to escape), judge of any court in 1 2 the unified judicial system, the Attorney General of 3 Pennsylvania, a deputy attorney general, district attorney, assistant district attorney, member of the General Assembly, 4 5 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Auditor General, State Treasurer, State law enforcement official, local law 6 7 enforcement official, Federal law enforcement official or 8 person employed to assist or assisting any law enforcement 9 official in the performance of his duties, who was killed in 10 the performance of his duties or as a result of his official 11 position.
