AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for special speed limits on roads
3 bordering residential areas.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3365 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 3365. Special speed limitations.

10 (c.1) Roads bordering residential areas.--No person shall
11 drive a vehicle at a speed greater than 25 miles per hour on any
12 road within 200 feet of a residential area. An official traffic-
13 control device shall indicate the beginning and the end of the
14 roadway subject to this subsection. The municipality in which
15 the roadway is located shall have the power to designate the
16 roadways that are subject to this subsection.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
