- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for paintball guns and
- 3 markers.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6102 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 8 § 6102. Definitions.
- 9 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 10 provisions of this subchapter which are applicable to specific
- 11 provisions of this subchapter, the following words and phrases,
- 12 when used in this subchapter shall have, unless the context
- 13 clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this
- 14 section:
- 15 * * *
- 16 "Paintball qun." A device designed and manufactured to
- 17 propel, by gas or air, an encapsulated gelatin paintball.

- 1 <u>"Paintball marker." A device designed and manufactured</u> to
- 2 propel, by gas or air, an encapsulated gelatin paintball.

- 4 Section 2. Section 6106.1 of Title 18 is amended by adding a
- 5 subsection to read:
- 6 § 6106.1. Carrying loaded weapons other than firearms.
- 7 * * *
- 8 (a.1) Paintball guns and paintball markers.--
- 9 (1) Except as set forth in paragraph (2), an individual
- 10 <u>may not carry a paintball gun or a paintball marker in a</u>
- vehicle unless one of the following apply:
- 12 <u>(i) The paintball gun or paintball marker is</u>
- disassembled so that the propellant cannister is separate
- 14 <u>from the rest of the device.</u>
- 15 (ii) The propellant cannister of the paintball gun
- or paintball marker has been emptied of its gas or air
- 17 propellant.
- 18 (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to a commercial
- 19 paintball field, range or course where passengers are being
- 20 <u>transported by the commercial field, range or course operator</u>
- 21 to and from designated player areas.
