AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 28, 1947 (P.L.1068, No.459), entitled  
2 "An act directing the Department of Military Affairs to  
3 select, procure, award and provide for the furnishing of  
4 certain service medals," further providing for eligibility  
5 for certain service medals; making an appropriation; and  
6 making an editorial change.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 2 of the act of June  
10 28, 1947 (P.L.1068, No.459), entitled "An act directing the  
11 Department of Military Affairs to select, procure, award and  
12 provide for the furnishing of certain service medals," are  
13 amended to read:

15 Directing the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to

1 select, procure, award and provide for the furnishing of  
2 certain service medals.

3 Section 1. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs  
4 of the Commonwealth shall select, procure, award and provide for  
5 the furnishing, at request of the veteran, of a service medal[,  
6 at cost,] to honorably discharged [Army, Navy, Coast Guard and  
7 United States Marine Corps] Veterans of World War II, who [were]  
8 are current residents of Pennsylvania [at the time of their  
9 entry into the service]: Provided, That such medals shall be  
10 given only for service covering any period of time between the  
11 seventh day of December, one thousand nine hundred forty-one,  
12 and the [second day of September, one thousand nine hundred  
13 forty-five] thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine  
14 hundred forty-six. The detailed specifications and design shall  
15 be selected by the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.  
16 Section 2. The sum of \$2,000,000, or as much thereof as may  
17 be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
18 Military and Veterans Affairs in order to carry out the  
19 provisions of this act.  
20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
