A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of May 2001 as "Senior Citizens' Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives wishes to honor the
4 outstanding contributions senior citizens have made to our
5 Commonwealth; and

6 WHEREAS, In 1998 there were approximately 3.69 million
7 Pennsylvanians over 50 years of age and 1.9 million
8 Pennsylvanians over 65 years of age; and

9 WHEREAS, The population of senior citizens continues to rise,
10 and the Commonwealth must prepare to meet the special needs of
11 senior citizens, such as affordable health care; and

12 WHEREAS, These hardworking men and women have had an enormous

1 impact on our future and have enriched our heritage; and

2 WHEREAS, Senior citizens are the foundation of a stable
3 community; and

4 WHEREAS, Other world cultures treasure their elderly,
5 honoring their wisdom and life experience; therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
7 month of May 2001 as "Senior Citizens' Month" in Pennsylvania.
