## AN ACT

- 1 Requiring certain information to be included on consumer
- 2 invoices generated through mail or telephone orders.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Consumer
- 7 Invoice Protection Act.
- 8 Section 2. Consumer invoice requirements.
- 9 Any company registered to do business in this Commonwealth
- 10 that accepts orders for goods or services through the United
- 11 States mail or telephone from consumers who are citizens of this
- 12 Commonwealth shall provide on any invoice generated from such
- 13 orders a telephone number that may be called and a box that may
- 14 be checked in order for consumers to discontinue the good or
- 15 service.
- 16 Section 3. Violation.
- 17 A violation of this act shall constitute a violation of the

- 1 act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair
- 2 Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.
- 3 Section 4. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
