AN ACT

1 Requiring certain information to be included on consumer
2 invoices generated through mail or telephone orders.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Short title.

6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Consumer
7 Invoice Protection Act.

8 Section 2. Consumer invoice requirements.

9 Any company registered to do business in this Commonwealth
10 that accepts orders for goods or services through the United
11 States mail or telephone from consumers who are citizens of this
12 Commonwealth shall provide on any invoice generated from such
13 orders a telephone number that may be called and a box that may
14 be checked in order for consumers to discontinue the good or
15 service.

16 Section 3. Violation.

17 A violation of this act shall constitute a violation of the

1 act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair
2 Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.

3 Section 4. Effective date.

4 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
