## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for possession of
- 3 weapon on school property.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 912 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 912. Possession of weapon on school property.
- 9 (a) [Definition.--Notwithstanding the definition of "weapon"
- 10 in section 907 (relating to possessing instruments of crime),
- 11 "weapon" for purposes of this section shall include but not be
- 12 limited to any knife, cutting instrument, cutting tool, nun-
- 13 chuck stick, firearm, shotgun, rifle and any other tool,
- 14 instrument or implement capable of inflicting serious bodily
- 15 injury.] Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 16 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 17 <u>subsection:</u>
- 18 "Firearm." Any weapon, including a starter gun, which will

- 1 or is designed to expel a projectile or projectiles by the
- 2 action of an explosion, expansion of gas or escape of gas. The
- 3 term does not include any device designed or used exclusively
- 4 for the firing of stud cartridges, explosive rivets or similar
- 5 industrial ammunition.
- 6 <u>"Weapon." Notwithstanding the definition of "weapon" in</u>
- 7 <u>section 907 (relating to possessing instruments of crime), for</u>
- 8 purposes of this section the term shall include, but not be
- 9 <u>limited to, any knife, cutting instrument, cutting tool, nun-</u>
- 10 chuck stick, firearm, shotgun, rifle and any other tool,
- 11 <u>instrument or implement capable of inflicting serious bodily</u>
- 12 <u>injury</u>.
- 13 (b) Offense defined.--A person commits a misdemeanor of the
- 14 first degree if he possesses a weapon in the buildings of, on
- 15 the grounds of, or in any conveyance providing transportation to
- 16 or from any elementary or secondary publicly-funded educational
- 17 institution, any elementary or secondary private school licensed
- 18 by the Department of Education or any elementary or secondary
- 19 parochial school.
- 20 (c) Defense.--It shall be a defense that the weapon is
- 21 possessed and used in conjunction with a lawful supervised
- 22 school activity or course or is possessed for other lawful
- 23 purpose.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
