## AN ACT

9	Section 1. Section 1326 of the act of March 10, 1949
10	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is

12	Section 1326. DefinitionsThe term "compulsory school
13	age," as hereinafter used, shall mean the period of a child's
14	life from the time the child's parents elect to have the child
15	enter school, which shall be not later than at the age of [eight
16	(8)] <u>six (6)</u> years, until the age of seventeen (17) years. The
17	term shall not include any child who holds a certificate of
18	graduation from a regularly accredited senior high school.
19	The term "migratory child." wherever used in this subdivision

of this article, shall include any child domiciled temporarily
in any school district for the purpose of seasonal employment,
but not acquiring residence therein, and any child accompanying
his parent or guardian who is so domiciled.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
