Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for cruelty to 3 animals. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5511(a)(2.1)(ii) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended December 9, 2002 (P.L.1439, No.183), is amended and the section is amended by 8 adding a subsection to read: 10 § 5511. Cruelty to animals. 11 (a) Killing, maiming or poisoning domestic animals or zoo 12 animals, etc.--13 (2.1)14 15 (ii) Any person convicted of violating the

provisions of this paragraph shall be sentenced to pay a

fine of not less than \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not

more than [two] <u>five</u> years, or both. The court may also

order a presentence mental evaluation. A subsequent

conviction under this paragraph shall be a felony of the

third degree. This paragraph shall apply to dogs and cats

only.

- 9 (m.2) Certain offenses.--In addition to any other penalty
- 10 provided by law, a person convicted of a second or subsequent
- 11 offense of cruelty to animals involving a dog or cat under
- 12 <u>subsection (c) shall be charged with a misdemeanor of the third</u>
- 13 <u>degree</u>.
