| 8      | The General Assembly declares that it is the public policy of  |
| 9      | this Commonwealth, when in the best interest of the child, to  |
| 10     | assure a reasonable and continuing contact of the child with   |
| 11     | both parents after a separation or dissolution of the marriage   |
| 12     | and the sharing of the rights and responsibilities of child  |
| 13     | rearing by both parents and continuing contact of the child or   |
| 14     | children with grandparents or siblings when a parent is  |
| 15     | deceased, divorced or separated and when continuing contact as   |
| 16     | determined by the court is in the best interest of the child due   |

- 2 Section 2. Title 23 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 3 <u>§ 5315. Sibling visitation.</u>
- 4 <u>The court shall award visitation rights to a sibling when</u>
- 5 continuing contact is in the best interest of the child.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
