8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 321 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
10	No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended
11	November 22, 1968 (P.L.1079, No.331), is amended to read:
12	Section 321. Compensation; Oath of Office <u>(a)</u> All persons
13	elected or appointed as school directors [shall serve without
14	pay except] <u>may be compensated</u> as hereinafter provided. Before
15	entering upon the duties of their office each shall take and
16	subscribe to the following oath or affirmation, which may be
17	administered by any one qualified to administer an oath, or as
18	hereinafter provided:

19 I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, obey and

defend the Constitution of the United States and the
Constitution of this Commonwealth, and that I will discharge the
duties of my office with fidelity.

4 (b) Every school board member, elected or appointed after

- 5 the effective date of this subsection, may be entitled to
- 6 <u>compensation as determined by the board of school directors</u>
- 7 prior to the term for which the member is appointed or elected.
- 8 The maximum annual compensation, excluding benefits, shall not
- 9 exceed fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
