AN ACT

Placing a moratorium on licensure or certification on certain health care facilities by the Department of Health.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Short title.

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Health Care

Facility Moratorium Act.

Section 2. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
context clearly indicates otherwise:
"Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
"Facility." Any of the following:
(1) A long-term care facility.
(2) A nursing home.
(3) A skilled nursing facility.
(4) A skilled nursing facility in an acute care
hospital.
"Unit." A rehabilitation unit in an acute care hospital. Section 3. Moratorium on licensure or certification.
(a) Facilities.--For a period of 18 months or until the department promulgates new regulations for the licensure or certification of facilities, whichever is later, the department may not license or certify a facility.
(b) Units.--For a period of 18 months or until the department promulgates new regulations for the licensure or certification of units, whichever is later, the department may not survey a unit.

Section 4. Expansion of capacity.
Nothing in this act shall prohibit a currently licensed or certified facility or unit from increasing its bed capacity by ten beds or $10 \%$ of its present capacity.

Section 10. Effective date.
This act shall take effect immediately.
