AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, 2 3 and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of 4 the first and second classes including those within a county of the second class and counties of the second class A through eighth classes, individually or jointly, to plan 6 7 their development and to govern the same by zoning, 8 subdivision and land development ordinances, planned residential development and other ordinances, by official 9 maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public 10 purpose and by the acquisition of such land; to promote the 11 12 conservation of energy through the use of planning practices 13 and to promote the effective utilization of renewable energy 14 sources; providing for the establishment of planning 15 commissions, planning departments, planning committees and 16 zoning hearing boards, authorizing them to charge fees, make 17 inspections and hold public hearings; providing for 18 mediation; providing for transferable development rights; 19 providing for appropriations, appeals to courts and penalties 20 for violations; and repealing acts and parts of acts," providing for an increase in use and occupancy permit fees 21 22 for the support of volunteer fire departments and ambulance 23 and rescue squads.
- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known
- 27 as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, reenacted and
- 28 amended December 21, 1988 (P.L.1329, No.170), is amended by

- Section 509.1. Support of Volunteer Fire Departments, 2
- 3 Ambulance and Rescue Squads. -- The governing body of a
- 4 <u>municipality may increase the fee for use and occupancy permits</u>
- 5 in the amount of \$5 for the purpose of financial support for
- local volunteer fire departments and ambulance and rescue 6
- 7 squads.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 8
