- 12 Section 1522.1. Sewage Sludge Testing. -- The board of
- 13 supervisors may by ordinance require unannounced, independent
- testing of sewage sludge that is to be land-applied within the 14
- boundaries of the township. The board of supervisors may select 15
- the testing facility of its choice to conduct the testing, and 16
- 17 the testing facility shall use the testing methods approved in
- regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection. The 18

- board of supervisors shall have the power to require that the 1
- 2 costs of the testing performed pursuant to the ordinance be
- 3 borne entirely by either the entity land-applying the sewage
- 4 <u>sludge or the owner of the land where the sewage sludge is being</u>
- applied. 5
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
