AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Department of Health for services
- 2 for children with special needs for the fiscal year beginning
- 3 July 1, 2003.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Appropriation.
- 7 The sum of \$87,000 is hereby appropriated to the Department
- 8 of Health for services for children with special needs for the
- 9 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003. This appropriation includes
- 10 funding for spina bifida services, \$50,000 for the ventilator-
- 11 assisted children's home program including case management and
- 12 respite care services, and public awareness activities related
- 13 to folic acid ingestion.
- 14 Section 2. Construction.
- 15 The sum appropriated in section 1 shall be construed as a

- supplement to the State appropriation to the Department of 1
- 2 Health for services for children with special needs set forth in
- 3 section 215 of the act of March 20, 2003 (P.L., No.1A), known as
- 4 the General Appropriation Act of 2003.
- Section 3. Effective date. 5
- 6 This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, or immediately,
- 7 whichever occurs later.
