## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 20, 2003 (P.L. , No.1A), entitled 1 "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of 2 3 the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 4 Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for 5 the fiscal year July 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills б 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 2003; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance 10 Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores 11 Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust 12 Fund, the Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking Department Fund, the 13 14 Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology 15 Development Authority Fund and the Tobacco Settlement Fund to 16 the Executive Department; to provide appropriations from the 17 Judicial Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 18 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2003, to June 30, 19 2004; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund 20 for the fiscal year July 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004, for the proper operation of the several departments of the 21 22 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to 23 spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of 24 25 the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted

receipt accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 2003, to June 1 30, 2004, and for the payment of bills remaining unpaid at 2 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003; to provide 3 for the additional appropriation of Federal and State funds 4 5 from the General Fund, for the Executive Department of the 6 Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining 7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002; 8 and making a repeal, " adding a State appropriation related to 9 10 sewage treatment plant operations. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 213 of the act of March 20, 2003 (P.L. 14 , No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2003, is 15 amended by adding a State appropriation to read: 16 Section 213. Department of Environmental Protection. -- The 17 18 following amounts are appropriated to the Department of Environmental 19 20 Protection: Federal State \* \* \* 21 22 For sewage facilities enforcement 23 grants. 24 State appropriation..... 5,000,000 25 For sewage treatment plant 26 operation grants. 27 State appropriation..... 52,122,000 28 \* \* \* Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 29
