AN ACT

- Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, establishing the Pennsylvania Wildlife
 and Conservation Heritage Account; and further providing for
 deposit of disposal fee and for adjustments from the
 Environmental Stewardship Fund.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 10 § 6114. Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage
- 11 Account.
- 12 (a) Establishment.--The Pennsylvania Wildlife and
- 13 Conservation Heritage Account is hereby established as a
- 14 separate fund within the State Treasury. The moneys of the
- 15 account are hereby appropriated on a continuing basis to carry
- 16 out the provisions of this section.

- 1 (b) Source of funding. -- The moneys of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account shall consist of the
- 3 portion of the recycling fee allocated under section 6112(b)
- 4 (relating to extension of fees), all interest earned on those
- 5 moneys and any other moneys appropriated or made available to
- 6 the department for deposit into the account.
- 7 (c) Allocation. -- The moneys of the Pennsylvania Wildlife and
- 8 Conservation Heritage Account shall be allocated annually as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) 45% to a restricted revenue account within the
- 11 <u>Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account for</u>
- 12 <u>use by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.</u>
- 13 (2) 45% to a restricted revenue account within the
- 14 <u>Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account for</u>
- use by the Pennsylvania Game Commission.
- 16 (3) 10% to a restricted revenue account within the
- 17 <u>Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account for</u>
- 18 transfer to the Wild Resource Conservation Fund.
- 19 (d) Use of account.--
- 20 (1) The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission shall use
- 21 <u>its allocation under subsection (c)(1) for the construction</u>
- 22 and rehabilitation of infrastructure and habitat development
- 23 or improvement.
- 24 (2) The Pennsylvania Game Commission shall use its
- 25 <u>allocation under subsection (c)(2) for the construction and</u>
- 26 <u>rehabilitation of infrastructure, habitat development or</u>
- improvement and wildlife management programs.
- 28 (3) The amount allocated under subsection (c)(3) to the
- 29 <u>Wild Resource Conservation Fund shall be used for the</u>
- 30 purposes specified for that fund in the act of June 23, 1982

- 1 (P.L.597, No.170), known as the Wild Resource Conservation
- 2 Act.
- 3 <u>(e) Administrative expense limitation.--</u>
- 4 (1) The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission and the
- 5 <u>Pennsylvania Game Commission shall not expend any moneys from</u>
- 6 the Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account
- 7 <u>under subsection (c)(1) or (2) on administrative expenses.</u>
- 8 (2) Any department that receives moneys from the
- 9 <u>Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account from</u>
- 10 subsection (c)(3) may not expend more than 2% of the moneys
- on administrative expenses.
- 12 Section 2. Sections 6302 and 6306 of Title 27 are amended to
- 13 read:
- 14 § 6302. Deposit of disposal fee.
- The fees received by the department pursuant to section 6301
- 16 <u>(relating to disposal fee for municipal waste landfills) shall</u>
- 17 be paid into the State Treasury as follows:
- 18 (1) For the fiscal year 2002-2003, fees received by the
- department pursuant to section 6301 [(relating to disposal
- fee for municipal waste landfills)] shall be paid into the
- 21 State Treasury as follows:
- (i) The first \$50,000,000 in fees collected shall be
- 23 deposited into the Environmental Stewardship Fund
- 24 established in Chapter 61 (relating to environmental
- stewardship and watershed protection).
- 26 (ii) Any fees collected thereafter shall be
- deposited in the General Fund.
- 28 (2) For the fiscal year 2003-2004 and beyond, [all] the
- first \$12,500,000 in fees collected shall be deposited into
- 30 the Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage Account

- 1 <u>and the balance of the</u> fees collected shall be deposited into
- the Environmental Stewardship Fund [established in Chapter
- 3 61].
- 4 [§ 6306. Adjustments.
- 5 When the Governor's proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal
- 6 year, as submitted pursuant to section 12 of Article VIII of the
- 7 Constitution of Pennsylvania, contains a revision to the revenue
- 8 estimate for the current year of at least 3% less than the
- 9 official revenue estimate for the current year, the funds
- 10 deposited pursuant to section 6302(2) (relating to deposit of
- 11 disposal fee) may be adjusted by transferring or redirecting up
- 12 to 25% of these deposits to the General Fund.]
- 13 Section 3. This amendatory act shall be known and may be
- 14 cited as the Pennsylvania Wildlife and Conservation Heritage
- 15 Act.
- 16 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
