## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Homeland Security Force.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 1109. Homeland Security Force.
- 8 The Pennsylvania National Guard shall include a permanent
- 9 Homeland Security Force comprised of at least 1,000 members.
- 10 Members of the Homeland Security Force shall be full-time,
- 11 active duty members of the Pennsylvania National Guard and shall
- 12 be specially trained to defend against and respond to terrorist
- 13 threats or attacks within this Commonwealth.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
