- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled,
- as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death
- 3 benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of
- 4 firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law
- 5 enforcement officers or National Guard members killed in the
- 6 performance of their duties, "further providing for death
- 7 benefit eligibility.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 2.1 of the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, <-
- 11 No. 101), referred to as the Emergency and Law Enforcement
- 12 Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended April 2, 2002 (P.L.213,
- 13 No.20), is amended to read:
- 14 Section 2.1. This act shall be broadly construed to grant
- 15 benefits to firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad

- 1 members, law enforcement officers or National Guard personnel
- 2 for deaths related to the performance of their duties. A
- 3 firefighter, ambulance service or rescue squad member, law
- 4 <u>enforcement officer or National Guard member who suffers a fatal</u>
- 5 heart attack or stroke while on duty or not later than 24 hours
- 6 <u>after participating in a physical training exercise or</u>
- 7 <u>responding to an emergency is presumed to have died in the line</u>
- 8 of duty for purposes of this act.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
- 10 SECTION 1. THE TITLE OF THE ACT OF JUNE 24, 1976 (P.L.424, <---
- 11 NO.101), REFERRED TO AS THE EMERGENCY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 12 PERSONNEL DEATH BENEFITS ACT, AMENDED APRIL 2, 2002 (P.L.213,
- 13 NO.20), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 14 AN ACT
- 15 PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF DEATH BENEFITS TO THE SURVIVING
- 16 SPOUSE OR CHILDREN OR PARENTS OF FIREFIGHTERS, AMBULANCE
- 17 SERVICE OR RESCUE SQUAD MEMBERS, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OR
- 18 NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS [KILLED IN] WHO DIED AS A RESULT OF
- 19 THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.
- 20 SECTION 2. SECTION 1(A) OF THE ACT, AMENDED APRIL 2, 2002
- 21 (P.L.213, NO.20), IS AMENDED AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY
- 22 ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ:
- 23 SECTION 1. (A) IN THE EVENT A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER,
- 24 AMBULANCE SERVICE OR RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER, FIREFIGHTER OR
- 25 NATIONAL GUARD MEMBER [IS KILLED IN] <u>DIED AS A RESULT OF</u> THE
- 26 PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES, SUCH POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR, IN THE
- 27 CASE OF NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS, THE ADJUTANT GENERAL, WITHIN 30
- 28 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF DEATH, SHALL SUBMIT CERTIFICATION OF SUCH
- 29 DEATH TO THE COMMONWEALTH.
- 30 (A.1) A FIREFIGHTER, AMBULANCE SERVICE OR RESCUE SQUAD

- 1 MEMBER, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR NATIONAL GUARD MEMBER WHO
- 2 SUFFERS A FATAL HEART ATTACK OR STROKE WHILE ON DUTY OR NOT
- 3 <u>LATER THAN 24 HOURS AFTER PARTICIPATING IN A PHYSICAL TRAINING</u>
- 4 EXERCISE OR RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY IS PRESUMED TO HAVE DIED
- 5 AS A RESULT OF THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES FOR PURPOSES OF
- 6 THIS ACT.
