9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

12	Section 115. Prohibiting Flagging of Student Responses to
13	PSSA TestNo person or organization that corrects the
14	<u>Pennsylvania System of School Assessment tests may flag student</u>
15	responses. The Department of Education shall enforce this
16	section.
17	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
