AN ACT

- 1 Requiring automatic external defibrillators in law enforcement
 - vehicles; and providing civil immunity under certain
- 3 circumstances.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Law
- 8 Enforcement Vehicle Automatic External Defibrillator Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Automatic external defibrillator." A portable device that
- 14 uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm to an
- 15 individual in cardiac arrest.
- 16 "Law enforcement entity." The Pennsylvania State Police, a

- 1 police department of a municipality, a regional police
- 2 department and a county sheriff's department.
- 3 Section 3. Automatic external defibrillators required.
- 4 (a) General rule. -- Within 90 days of the effective date of
- 5 this act, a law enforcement entity shall acquire and maintain an
- 6 automatic external defibrillator in each vehicle used by the law
- 7 enforcement entity.
- 8 (b) Duties.--A law enforcement entity shall:
- 9 (1) In accordance with subsection (c), provide training
- 10 to persons assigned to each vehicle in which the automatic
- 11 external defibrillator will be primarily stored.
- 12 (2) Secure the automatic external defibrillator in a
- safe and readily accessible location within the vehicle and
- properly maintain and test the automatic external
- defibrillator according to the manufacturer's operational
- 16 quidelines.
- 17 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the automatic
- 18 external defibrillator from a licensed medical practitioner
- in this Commonwealth.
- 20 (c) Training. -- The personnel of a law enforcement entity who
- 21 are expected to use the automatic external defibrillators
- 22 required by this act shall complete training in cardiopulmonary
- 23 resuscitation and in the use of an automatic external
- 24 defibrillator provided by the American Heart Association or the
- 25 American Red Cross or through an equivalent course of
- 26 instruction approved by the department.
- 27 Section 4. Civil immunity.
- The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to good
- 29 Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external
- 30 defibrillator) shall apply to personnel of a law enforcement

- 1 entity who render care with an automatic external defibrillator.
- 2 Section 5. Effective date.
- 3 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
