A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee of the
2 United States Postal Service to issue a commemorative stamp
3 honoring coal miners.

4 WHEREAS, Our entire nation owes our coal miners a great deal
5 more than we could ever repay them for the difficult and
6 dangerous job which they perform so that we can have the fuel we
7 need to operate our industries and to heat our homes; and

8 WHEREAS, Coal mining is as much of a culture as it is an
9 industry; and

10 WHEREAS, Coal miners sacrifice life and limb for little
11 recognition, and it would be proper and fitting for our nation

1 to recognize our coal miners, past and present, for their
2 contributions; therefore be it

3 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
4 Pennsylvania memorialize the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee
5 of the United States Postal Service to issue a commemorative
6 stamp honoring our coal miners and their contributions to our
7 nation and its citizens; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to the
